#### § 50-1. Definitions.<sup>1</sup>

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

INTENT TO CONSUME — Drinking from the container, with alcohol on the breath of the possessor and/or any circumstances evidencing an intent to ultimately consume on any public lands.

OPEN CONTAINER — A container with the contents exposed to the atmosphere or the seal thereof broken.

#### § 50-2. Open containers.<sup>2</sup>

No person shall have, possess, carry or transport with the intent to consume or actually consume liquor, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot or other public place in the Village of Camden except in sealed bottles or other sealed containers, and no person shall drink or otherwise consume liquor, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot or other public place in the Village of Camden, whether on foot, in an automobile or any other vehicle or otherwise.

#### § 50-3. Exceptions.<sup>3</sup>

- A. The prohibitions of § 50-2 shall not apply in the event of a fair, picnic or other community gathering for which special written permission has been granted by the village.

- B. The prohibitions of § 50-2 shall not apply to the transportation of an unsealed but not open container across public lands of the village from one point to another, with no intent to consume the contents of such open container while upon public lands.

**§ 50-4. Penalties for offenses.**

Any violation of any provision of this chapter shall be punishable as provided in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article II, General Penalty.
