§ 86-1. Title.

This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Games of Chance Law of the Village of Camden."

§ 86-2. Conduct of games.

It shall be lawful for any authorized organization, upon obtaining the required license therefor, to conduct games of chance within the Village of Camden, subject to the provisions of this chapter, the provisions of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and the provisions and regulations promulgated by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board.

§ 86-3. Definitions.

The terms "authorized organization" and "games of chance" shall have the meanings stated in § 186 of the General Municipal Law.

§ 86-4. Conduct of games on Sunday.

Games of chance may be conducted on Sundays between the hours of 12:00 noon and 12:00 midnight if so provided in the license issued hereunder except on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day and New Year's Eve when no games of chance shall be permitted.

§ 86-5. Delegation of authority.

Pursuant to Part 5600.2 of the Rules and Regulations of Games of Chance, there is hereby delegated to the Village Clerk the responsibility and authority granted to the Board of Trustees of the Village of Camden by law in relation to the issuance and amendment of licenses and the collection, utilization and transmission of fees.

§ 86-6. Control and supervision. [Amended 4-11-1983 by L.L. No. 1-1983]

The Police Chief of the Village of Camden Police Department, or his lawfully designated agent, is hereby appointed chief law enforcement officer of the Village of Camden for the purposes of performing the powers and duties set forth in Subdivision 1 of § 194 of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

§ 86-7. Application of General Municipal Law.

This chapter shall be construed and applied in accordance with Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and games of chance shall be conducted in accordance therewith.

§ 86-8. Penalties for offenses.

The unauthorized conduct of a game of chance shall constitute and be punishable as a misdemeanor.
